

## Seedling Descriptions

Although the species listed have proven adaptable to Wyoming conditions, each species may have limited adaptability to local soil types and conditions. For more information on the plant species, we have publications and local resource personnel to assist you!

### Shrubs

01-CARAGANA: Medium/tall shrub; drought resistant and tolerant of alkaline soils.

02-COTONEASTER: Medium shrub; drought resistant and tolerant of alkaline soils.

04-CHOKECHERRY\*: Medium shrub; edible fruit for preserves.

05-LILAC: Tall shrub; good for windbreak purposes.

06-NATIVE PLUM\*: Tall shrub/short tree; does well in moist soils (excluding alkali); edible fruit for preserves.

07-SUMAC\*: Small to medium shrub; excellent drought resistance and tolerant of alkaline soils.

08-SAND CHERRY\*: Small shrub; best on sandy/loamy soils; edible fruit.

09-NANKING CHERRY: Medium, does well in most soils, good alkaline tolerance; edible fruit.

11-WOODS ROSE\*: Small shrub; grows well in moist soil.

12-BUFFALOBERRY\*: Medium/tall shrub; drought resistant and tolerant of alkaline soils.

14-GOLDEN CURRANT\*: Small/medium shrub, fairly drought/alkali tolerant; edible fruit.

17-RED-OSIER DOGWOOD\*: Small/medium sized; tolerant of flooding for moist streamside riparian sites.

18-NEW MEXICO PRIVET: Medium sized shrub; drought resistant-once established; alkaline tolerant.

19-WAX CURRANT\*: Small shrub; very good drought resistance; rapid growth; prefers sandy/loamy soils.

32-COYOTE WILLOW\*: Medium shrub; requires moist soil.

### Trees

20-GREEN ASH\*: Medium/tall tree; alkaline tolerant.

22-COTTONWOOD, HYBRID: Tall tree; fast growing; requires moist soil.

24-GOLDEN WILLOW: Medium to tall tree; requires moist soil.

25-HACKBERRY\*: Tall tree; drought resistant and tolerates alkaline well.

26-HONEYLOCUST: Medium/tall tree; drought resistant; open fine-textured; rapid growth rate.

30-BUR OAK: Medium/tall tree; drought resistant; tolerant of a wide range of soils.

34-PEACHLEAF WILLOW\*: Tall tree; requires moist soils.

35-PRAIRIE SKY COTTONWOOD: Medium/tall tree; requires moist soils; good canker resistance; usually cottonless.

200-ASPEN\*: Tall tree; requires moist soils.

213-NARROWLEAF COTTONWOOD\*: Tall tree; requires moist soils and tolerates alkaline well.

### Conifers

201-AUSTRIAN PINE: Tall tree; likes most soils of low pH; a good windbreak tree.

203-DOUGLAS FIR\*: Tall tree.

204-ENGELMANN SPRUCE\*: Tall tree; drought resistant.

208-PONDEROSA PINE\*: Tall tree; likes moist soils of low pH except heavy clay; better windbreak tree.

209-ROCKY MT. JUNIPER\*: Medium tree; drought resistant when established; excellent windbreak species.

211-WHITE FIR\*: Tall tree; very good drought resistance.

301-COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE: Tall tree; drought resistant when established.

309-EASTERN RED CEDAR: Medium tree; drought resistant when established, good windbreak species.

\*Native plants that have benefits for wildlife, and are suitable for wildscaping.

### Plan Before You Plant

A planting plan should be prepared before trees are ordered or planted. Develop a planting plan to plot the proper location for the planting, the best species for your site, spacing between rows, spacing between trees in the row and the correct number of trees and shrubs needed. The plan will also point out requirements for proper planting to gain initial survival and how to keep trees in a vigorous growing condition.
